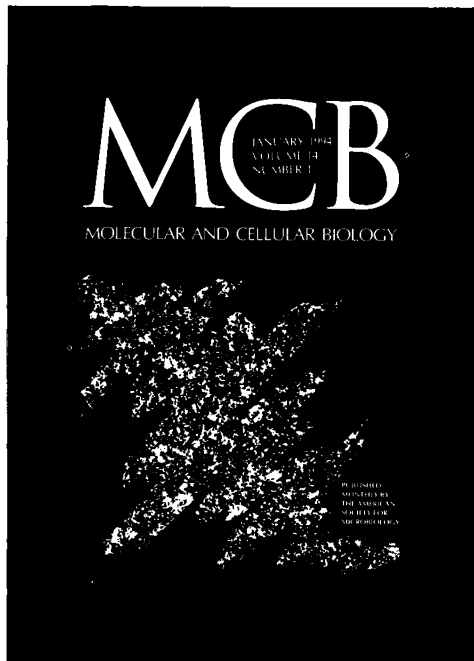


From eukaryotes to viruses . . . depend on these two ASM journals for cutting-edge science

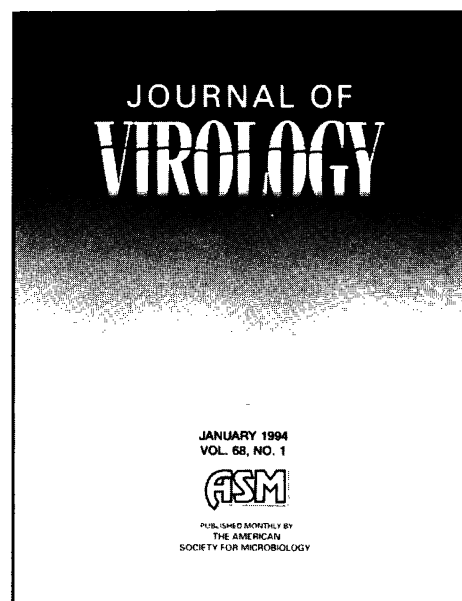
