Members may subscribe to one or more of these journals at special member rates; \$41 of the minimum dues payment of \$50 may be credited towards journal subscriptions. Memberships are initiated and renewed as of January each year. Unless there are directions to the contrary, membership nominations received prior to November 1 will be credited to the current year, and back issues of the selected publications for the current year will be furnished.
