Instructions to authors are published in the January issue each year; reprints are available from the editors and the Publications Department. The journal is published monthly, one volume per year. The nonmember subscription price is \$150 per year; single copies are \$21. The member subscription price is \$41 (foreign \$54 [surface rate]) per year; single copies are \$7. 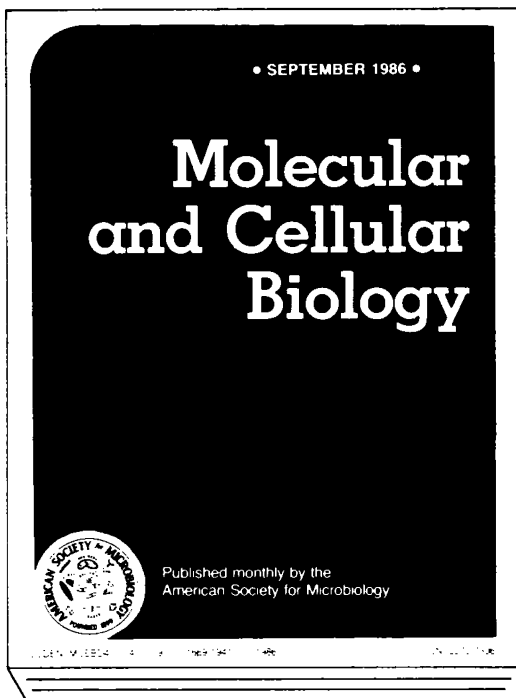

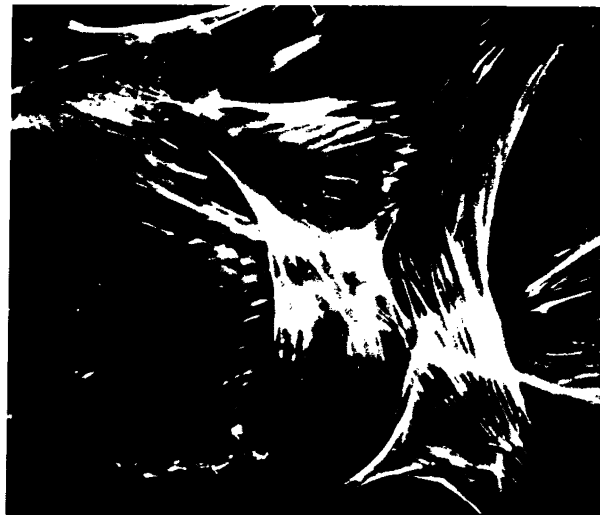
